



Instructions:

1. Print templates onto colored cardstock.
2. Using a ruler as a guide, use a bone folder or knitting needle to score along the dotted and dashed lines of the pop-up pieces and card.
3. Carefully cut out the pop-up pieces and card, following the solid gray lines around the shapes. Don't forget to cut out the heart-shaped piece in the center of the card.
4. Fold the pop-up pieces and card upward along the dashed lines that look like this , making valley folds. Fold downward along the dotted lines that look like this , making mountain folds.
5. Apply a small amount of glue to the gray areas marked "glue tab A here" and "glue tab B here" on the card.
6. Adhere tabs "A" and "B" of the base piece to the glued areas of the card. Press firmly and let the glue dry.
7. Take "body #1" and fold its arm over onto the body. Use a dab of glue to secure down the arm.
8. Apply a small amount of glue to the base piece on the gray area marked "glue body #1 here." Place body #1 over it, lining up the rounded edges of the shoulders with the rounded top of the base piece.
