## **Glove Animals**


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
Start with a pair of gloves.

2



Flip one of the gloves inside out, and using scissors, cut away the thumb, middle, and ring finger. Following the dotted lines, sew the cutaway part closed, leaving approximately a 0.2-inch border from the cut area.

3



Flip all four parts right-side out and fill them all with cotton.

4



Fold the opening of the arms inside approximately 0.2 inch and sew each of them onto the body.

5



Fold the opening of the tail inside approximately 0.2 inch as well, and sew it onto the body.

6



Take the other glove, flip it inside out, and cut away the thumb, middle, and ring fingers. Following the dotted line, sew the thumb part of the glove closed, leaving approximately a 0.2-inch border from the cut area.

Fold the glove so that the cut area of the thumb becomes the center. Sew a curved line to close the glove (see dotted line).

8



Cut along the curved line, leaving approximately a 0.2-inch border from the seam.

9



Flip the glove right-side out and fill it with cotton from the top of the head, excluding the ears.

10



Sew the cotton-filled portion closed. Fold over the ears and pin them down lightly with thread.

11



Sew the head onto the body, using a pin while sewing to hold them together if necessary.

12



Use buttons for the eyes and nose, and use a backstitch to sew a circle around one eye. Create a belly button with thread
