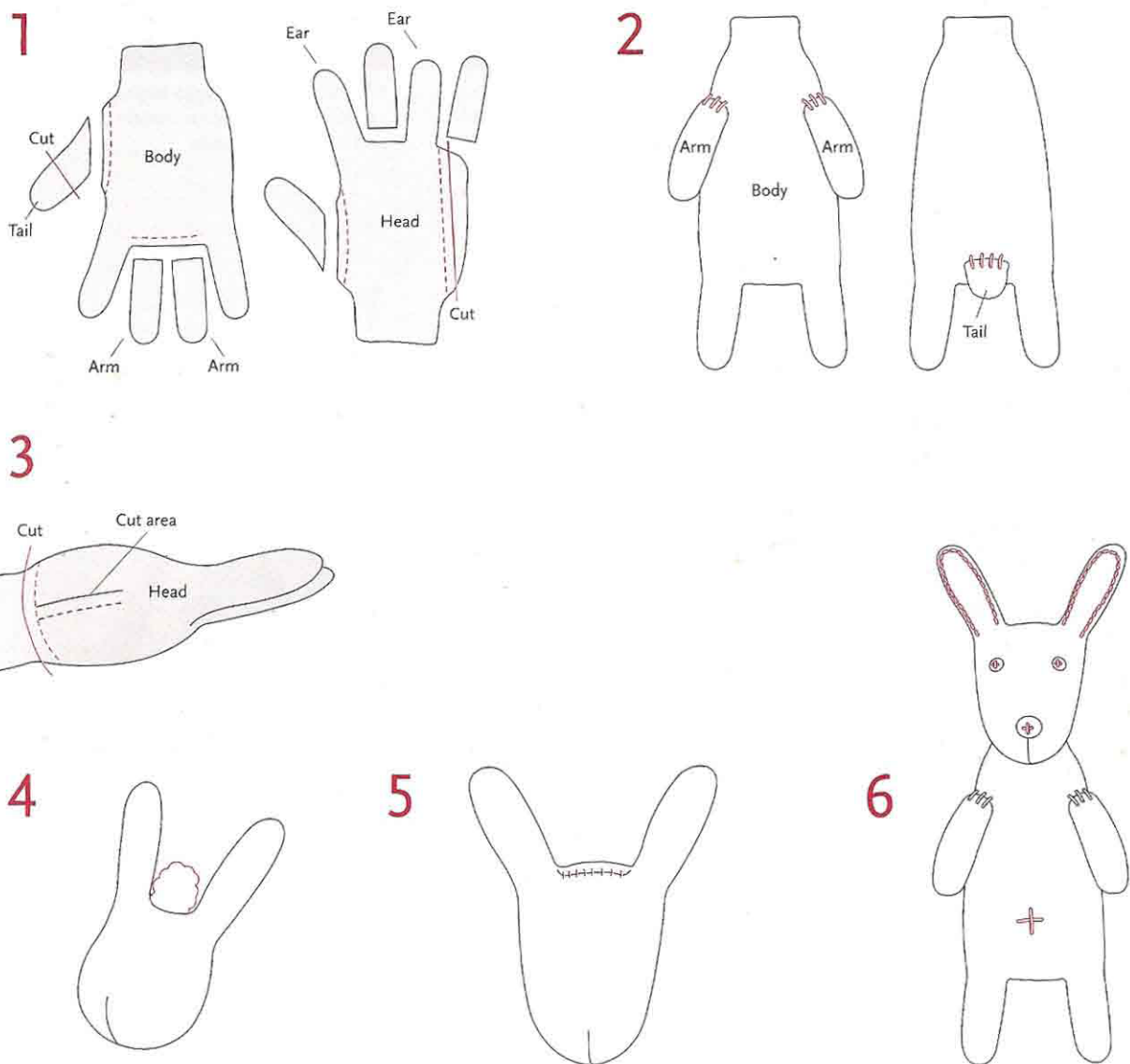


Glove Animals

Rabbit

- 1 Flip both gloves inside out and cut the fingers as shown in the diagram by the red solid lines. Sew as directed by the red dotted lines. Leave approximately a 0.2-inch border from the seam and cut the excess.
- 2 Flip the body, arms, and tail right-side out and fill with cotton. Fold the open parts of the arms and tail inside approximately 0.2 inch and sew them onto the body.
- 3 For the head, fold the glove so that the thumb area that was cut open (and sewn shut) is in the center (as shown in the diagram). Sew as directed by the red dotted lines and then cut away, leaving approximately a 0.2-inch border of space from the seam.
- 4 Flip the head right-side out and fill with cotton.
- 5 Fill the ears with cotton as well and sew the opening closed.
- 6 Sew the head onto the body. Use buttons for the eyes and the nose and a backstitch for the ears. Create a belly button with thread.
