

Flower Arrangement 4

Use 1/8" paper unless specified.

Container

Weave seven horizontal 1 1/2" lengths of rust paper and five vertical 1 1/2" lengths of rust paper together. Glue where the vertical strips cross the horizontal strips. Using the pattern, cut out the basket shape. The basket should measure 1 1/8" wide by 7/8" high. (Do not glue the basket flat to the background; see assembly instructions below.)



Stems

Cut one 3", one 2 3/4", one 2 1/2", one 2 1/4" and one 1 7/8" lengths of green wire. Wrap green paper around the lengths of wire to make the stems, and glue to the flowers.

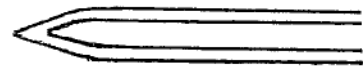
Fringed Flowers (make 5)

Fringe a 4" length of 3/8" yellow paper, and roll into a tight circle. Using your fingers, push the fringes outward as shown in the diagram. Glue each flower to a stem.



Two-tone Large Leaves (make 6)

Cut the leaf shapes out of a length of 1/4" green paper and a slightly smaller one out of 1/4" soft green paper. Glue the smaller leaf on top of the larger leaf as shown. Make one 3", one 2 3/4", one 2 1/2", one 2 1/4", one 1 7/8" & one 1 1/4".



Leaves (make 4)

Roll twenty-four 2" pale green marquises. Two leaves are made using seven marquises and two leaves are made using five marquises. Cut seven lengths of 1 1/4" pale green paper and glue the leaves to it as shown at right.



Assembly

First, curve the top center of the basket out slightly and glue its sides and bottom to the background. Arrange the flowers and leaves in the basket as shown in the photo, and glue them in place.
