




INSTRUCTIONS

Print the tiled templates or use the grid method described below to draw birds at desired sizes.

USING THE GRID METHOD

Use the grid method to transfer the templates onto the barrier. Print the grid method template so you can see the details of the pattern. determine how wide you want the image in inches; divide that width by the number of squares in the template's width. that number is the size you should make each square in the grid. use chalk and a yardstick to create the grid on the barrier. trace the bird freehand with chalk, copying the image square by square. Cut out.




TILING INSTRUCTIONS


To assemble the tiled template:

1. Using the image below as a guide, lay template out on work surface; the numbers at the top of each sheet (for example 3,2) denote first the column and then the row.
2. Using a ruler and craft knife, trim left side of each sheet at vertical crop marks. Repeat process to trim bottom of each sheet. Using remaining crop marks as a guide, align design and tape sheets together.





