Pet First-Aid Kit

- ☐ A list of emergency numbers, including your vet, an after-hours emergency animal hospital, and the National Animal Poison Control Center (800-548-2423)
- ☐ An expired library card -- perfect for scraping stingers from the skin
- ☐ Antihistamine
- ☐ Bandages
- ☐ Compact thermal blanket or "space blanket"
- ☐ Cotton-tipped applicator swabs
- ☐ First-aid book for pets
- ☐ Gauze
- ☐ Glycerine-based antibacterial cleanser
- ☐ Instant cold pack
- ☐ Latex gloves
- ☐ Leash
- ☐ Medical tape
- ☐ Muzzle
- ☐ Nonadhesive sterile pads
- ☐ Pen light
- ☐ Plunge syringe for administering liquid medication or flushing out eyes or wounds
- ☐ Scissors
- ☐ Syptic powder or cornstarch to help staunch bleeding
- ☐ 3 percent hydrogen peroxide for cleaning wounds
- ☐ Towel

- ☐ Tweezers
- ☐ Vet wraps that cling to legs and paws but not fur
