

TEMPLATE

Hard-boil and dye eggs; or dye raw eggs, then blow out the insides (blown-out eggs are light enough to sit on top of grass and will last for years). Print templates. Cut out with scissors or a utility knife, leaving heads attached where they touch. Rub a glue stick over backs of heads, excluding collars. Fold heads so backs align and stick together. Use glue stick to affix collars to eggs. Attach wings and arms next, applying glue only where paper will touch the egg.
